

# Technical Bulletin #15

This technical bulletin describes a Correspondent issue and its resolution.

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## Issue

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If you are a Correspondent user, you may not be able to download the Correspondent client if:

- You are running Netscape Enterprise Server on a Windows NT server, and
- You have installed Astoria or Web Services in a non-default location (i.e., a directory other than **c:\astoria**).

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## Resolution

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To be able to download the Correspondent client, you must edit your **obj.conf** file on your Web server. You can find your **obj.conf** file in a location similar to `c:\Netscape\SuiteSpot\https-servername\config`, where *servername* is the name of your Web server.

The **obj.conf** file will contain a section that looks like the following:

```
<Object ppath="C:/astoria/webbin/public/*.exe">
  ObjectType fn="force-type" type="application/octet-stream"
  Service fn="send-file"
</Object>
```

Change it to:

```
<Object ppath="C:/directory/webbin/public/*.exe">
  ObjectType fn="force-type" type="application/octet-stream"
  Service fn="send-file"
</Object>
```

Where *directory* is the non-default location in which you installed Astoria or Web Services.
