
Astoria 3.0 Technical Bulletin #2

This technical bulletin supplements the information provided in your Astoria 3.0 documentation with a newly-discovered issue and its resolution.

Issue

In standalone mode, Astoria 3.0 is unable to run Astoria tools as a non-administrator on the Windows NT workstation.

Resolution/Workaround

Until this issue is resolved, you must either add the user as a Windows NT workstation administrator or change the permissions on the Astoria key in the registry.

To change the permissions on the Astoria key in the registry:

1. Log on to the Windows NT workstation with administrator privileges.
2. Run the **regedt32.exe** file.
3. From HKEY_CLASSES_ROOT, click Astoria.
4. From the Security menu, click Permissions.

The Registry Key Permissions dialog box appears. The names of users and groups with permissions to access the key and the levels of access they have appear in Name.

5. Click Add.
6. Select the user to add.
This is the user for which you want to run Astoria applications in non-Administrator mode.
7. Click Add.
8. Change Type of Access to "Full Control".
9. Click OK.

10. Select the "Replace Permission on Existing Subkeys" check box.
11. Click OK.
12. Click Yes to replace the permission on all existing subkeys within Astoria.
13. Close the registry.
14. Log in as the user specified above.
